Information for drivers and supporters

The water section of the race course follows the Acheneau River, which runs through the village of Port St Père. The paddock and the rest of the race course are located on the marshes adjacent to the river.

As these meadows are prone to flooding in winter, the silt that settles there can turn into very fine dust in summer and clog the radiators of the hovercraft engines. We warn drivers about the risk of overheating that this could cause.

Paddock

Access to the paddock area will be permitted from Thursday, August 21 in the afternoon until Monday, August 25 at the end of the morning.

The race site will be monitored by security guards on Friday and Saturday nights.

When drivers register, they will be given an access badge for the driver's park and the campsite. Everyone must wear this badge throughout the weekend.

We must be vigilant about sorting waste. Trash cans are available in the paddock and camping areas. Yellow containers are for recyclable materials, green containers are for household waste. There are signs on each yellow trash can indicating what you can throw in it. Please bring a waterproof tarpaulin to place on the ground under the hovercrafts to prevent fuel spills. Collection drums for hydrocarbons will be set up in the paddock.

Scrutineering

Scrutineering of the hovercrafts and drivers registrations will begin on Friday, August 22, from 4:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. For late arrivals, they will take place on Saturday morning from 9:00 a.m. to 10:00 a.m.

As the race site is next to the village, we ask pilots and mechanics to respect the following times for starting the hovercraft engines: From 9 a.m. to 7 p.m. on Saturday and Sunday. Outside these hours, engines must be turned off, particularly during the lunch break and when the paddock is open, the times for which will be communicated at the driver briefing.

On Friday evening from 7 p.m., all pilots and supporters are invited to the Anjou Aéroglisseurs camp for a "friendly drink" to officially launch the French round of the European Hovercraft Championship.
